“Maundy Thursday,” from Latin, mandatum, meaning “commandment,” is traditionally a service called tenebrae, which is Latin for “darkness,” or “shadows.” It is a service on the night before Jesus died; a precursor of the “darkness [that] came over the whole land,” on the day of Jesus crucifixion.

The Gospel writer John’s version of the night before Jesus died gives us the name of this night: “Maundy.” Jesus said to his disciples, “This is my commandment (mandatum), that you love one another as I have loved you.” (John 15:12)

We will gather at 5:30 pm for a light supper of soup, bread and fruit in the Fellowship Hall, followed by a service in the Sanctuary at 6:45 pm. Our pew torches will light our worship as well as for our Easter Service on Sunday.
